Description of course: SAILS stands for Seamless Alignment and Integrated Learning Support. This comprehensive math course is made available to 12th grade students who did not score at least a 19 on their ACT. Completing SAILS will allow the math remediation requirements to be waived at all Tennessee Community Colleges, Colleges of Applied Technology, and some Universities, both public and private. SAILS is completely online but the students enrolled will be working in the computer lab during their scheduled math time. I will be the instructor and will be available to teach any concepts necessary and monitor their progress. They will receive a high school math credit for this course, and they will not be required to take any math remediation when they enter college.
